This term we are working on subtraction within 10. Many children still find complementary addition really tricky (5 and what makes 8) so any practise of this will help to consolidate the number bonds. We are also looking at measurement and time.

The children will continue to progress through ORT in reading and in Jolly Phonics we continue to look at digraphs and alternative spellings like ow/ou. Most children can now work out simple 3 letter words, and we are extending these skills.

Our topic this term is Fairyland, which is a literacy based adventure topic designed to excite children about reading and writing.
