

Appendix 1. Positive behaviours that we see and experience from Pupils, Parents and Staff that we want to continue to be evident in our school community:

- Children check the friendship bench to see if anybody is there
- Everybody playing together
- Playing with new people
- Checking if someone is OK if they have fallen over

- Being nice
- Want to work and concentrate on learning

- No swearing
