<p>Write your own book. It could be a comic book, graphic novel, story book, or non-fiction and remember to include illustrations or diagrams.</p>	<p>Collect all your teddies, Lego men, cushions... and divide them into different groups. How many equal groups can you make? How many groups can you make which have only 1 remainder?</p>	<p>Make a fantastic model with Lego, blocks, K'nex, junk etc. Then draw it carefully.</p>
<p>Log in to Glow and practice your typing skills in Word by typing a letter to a friend.</p>	<p>Create a symmetrical picture. Be creative, use Lego bricks, pens and paper, food or leaves and stones in the garden.</p>	<p>Create a matching pairs game in French e.g. numbers, animals or colours</p>
