Children received a drink and snack during the event, and prizes were given out for best dancer etc.

Christmas Events (11/11/22 & 2/12/22) – This year the PSC organized a shopping night and Christmas Fayre with Santa's Grotto. A massive amount of £3017.44 was raised with both events combined. Thanks to all!



Santa run (29/11/22 to 02/12/22) - Portlethen's annual santa run is organized by Portlethen Town Association to help raise money for Portlethen's primary schools. The school received an amazing £1045 donation.

On the Thursday the PSC served hot chocolate at the school to welcome Santa and we had an incredible turnout! Thank you all!



Christmas Cards – Packs from IQ Cards were sent home with pupils to design their personalized Christmas cards. The PSC receives a percentage of the sales from IQ which was £275 this year.

The school requested support from the PSCt to buy crafting materials for Christmas creations @ £401.20, and £420 to support design and technology resources for the school.

CLASS TRIPS - £10 per pupil (£2740)

At the last PSC meeting it was decided to again support school class trips at £10 per child. Class teachers will allocate this money to their trips, so that is something for the children to look forward to in the new year!

CHRISTMAS PARTIES & LUNCH - £197.08

The PSC has provided hot chocolate, a new CD player and Santa presents for the nursery Christmas party. In addition, snack bags are provided for all the primary class parties and Christmas crackers for the Christmas lunch.
