Dear parents/carers,

It has been lovely to welcome all the children back for the start of term. They have returned with news of their holidays, easter egg hunts and much more.



In maths, pupils will be extending and using and developing their knowledge of the four operations in different contexts and to identify and create patterns. They will be further developing knowledge of 2 and 3D shapes by creating accurate representations of shape using angles in nets. Data handling will be developed through Social Studies related surveys and the use of technology in handling and organising data.

As part of their Social Studies, P5 will be learning more about the natural world and living things. They will be carrying out nature surveys, studying life cycles of different living creatures, looking at how wildlife can help humans and the genetics of inheritance and adaptation. This will be linked to the environment, climate change and actions the pupils have put onto the class Eco Schools plan.

Literacy will focus on completing research with note taking and collating the information to present to the class in different ways. This will be linked to both writing and listening and talking. Pupils will be learning more about organising relevant information in a way that is interesting for their audience whether that is orally or written. Links and comparisons will be made through reading to support this.

**Health and Wellbeing** this term will include work within the role of P5 as **Digital Leaders** and furthering our work on Rights Respecting Schools. Linked to Social Studies will be an opportunity for pupils to learn more about food and nutrition through different phases of life and the harm substances can do to the healthy development of the human body. RSHP lessons for this term for P5 will be:

- My senses: Things I like, things I don't like
- Consent
- Social media/popular culture
- Protecting me/Abuse and relationships
